Keywords: List three to five keywords, each separated by semicolons.

Abstract: The abstract (including Tables and figures) must not exceed one A/4 page. Use Times New Roman, 12pt, single spaced, justified, font for the main text. Avoid using jargon and acronyms..

Consider including the following information in the abstract, when relevant:

- Objective, problem under investigation, hypothesis, or research goal
 - Description of research methods
 - Summary of findings
 - Statement of how the research advances the Biomedical Imaging field
- Footnotes (if any) should be located at the end of the abstract.
- Limited graphics are permitted:
- Paste graphics, figures and formulas directly into the text body.
 - Format figures, preferably as bitmaps.
 - Figures may be in **full color** for electronic distribution.
 - **Printed materials will be reproduced in black-and-white (grayscale) only!**
